OAK Racing is specialised in endurance racing and over the years it has become a benchmark among the LM P2 private teams. The doubles in LM P2 in the Le Mans 24 Hours and the FIA Endurance Trophy in 2013, the 2013 and 2014 Asian Le Mans Series titles and the team's stunning performance in the Tudor United SportsCar Championship in 2014, are all proof of its professionalism and competence.

OAK Racing is a leading team that fights at the front, and it also upholds the tradition which makes this form of racing a category dear to the heart of gentlemen drivers. The fact that the team is participating in the 2015 edition of the 24 Hours of Le Mans is a combination of these two aspects of endurance racing. The #34 Ligier JS P2 will be driven by the very quick trio of Chris Cumming – Kevin Estre – Laurens Vanthoor. The #35 Ligier JS P2, in the colours of Mécénat Chirurgie Cardiaque, is for its part entrusted to Erik Maris, Jean-Marc Merlin and Jacques Nicolet, a perfect team of gentlemen drivers.

Jacques Nicolet, creator and director of companies, OAK Racing president and driver:

"My vision of motor racing is to bring together men who share the same passion, the taste for work and the team spirit to achieve the best balance between reliability and performance. These values that are common to endurance and business are the ones that have always driven me to continue progressing. This year I'm adding the pleasure of seeing this team competing to that of getting back in the driving seat. I take a lot of pleasure at the wheel of the Ligier JS P2 with my teammates Erik Maris and Jean-Marc Merlin.

In 2013, Jacques Nicolet and Jean-Marc Merlin shared a Morgan LM P2 in the FIA World Endurance Championship including the Le Mans 24 Hours. This year they are together again at the wheel of a Ligier JS P2 and Erik Maris, who joined them for the Austin 6 Hours in 2013, teams up with the duo again.

At the wheel of the Ligier JS P2, chosen for its performance and its driving comfort, and equipped with a Nissan engine, the trio of gentlemen drivers is incredibly motivated: the very high level of the LM P2 field is not discouraging them, quite the opposite! After the rounds at Silverstone and Spa, their sixth place in the provisional LM P2 driver's FIA Endurance Trophy is proof of their perfect adaptation to their new car and confirms their ambition to complete the 2015 edition of the 24 Hours of Le Mans.



OAK Racing doubles its forces for the legendary Le Mans 24 Hours by entering a second Onroak Automotive chassis. The team has chosen the very quick trio of Chris Cumming, Kevin Estre and Laurens Vanthoor to drive the #34 Ligier JS P2, mounted with a Honda engine.

For their first participation in the 24 Hours of Le Mans, the three drivers are also fighting their first race in the LM P2 category: a double challenge at the height of the talent of the three new recruits at OAK Racing.

The tests organized by the team in Max confirmed the potential of this choice team, and the best time set by Laurens Vanthoor on the test day on the 31st of May is a very promising start for this great adventure that is the 24 Hours of Le Mans



The two Ligier JS P2s will both have Dunlop tyres supplied by the team's long-standing technical partner.

Philippe Dumas, Team Principal OAK Racing: « It's a double adventure for the team. We have on the #35 Ligier JS P2, a 100% gentlemen driver team, and our goal is to help them to have a car that's a pleasure to drive, so that they can enjoy themselves and that they get to the end of the 24 Hours. It's a nice adventure for three friends, but also quite a challenge that we're sharing with them. If no mistake is made, we can hope for quite a respectable result, and making it to the end of this race is already a victory. We will do our most to go to the chequered flag with Erik, Jean-Marc and Jacques! For the #34 Ligier JS P2, the goal is of course quite different. Laurens and Kevin are two extremely competitive and professional drivers, as well as being great guys. With Chris's support on this car, it's a trio who will be aiming for the podium, maybe more... The technical work completed with them during the tests and their ease of adapting to the Ligier JS P2 is very promising. Between the quality and professionalism of this frivers line-up and the Ligier JS P2-Honda-Dunlop package, we feel very ambitious for this race. But 24 hours is very long..."
